### Study / Discussion Questions:

1. The word testimony can be translated “*my story*” Are you able to share “*your story*” with others?
2. Why is our story the easiest, most comfortable approach to sharing the Gospel?
3. What are some of the key things that are a part of “*your story*” with Jesus?
4. Why, like Paul, should our stories include both what God has done and is currently doing?
5. Why does sharing your story often prevent listeners from arguing or turning off what you are saying?
6. Sometimes testimonials can turn into boastimonials, what do you think this might mean? What might the damage be from this? How can it be avoided?
7. What is your usual approach to sharing the gospel with people?
8. If you are not currently including your story in the process of sharing Christ with others, how might it be beneficial to avoid conflict?
9. Are there any other aspects of your story other than these 3 points?
  - My life before I made Jesus my Lord.
  - How I made Jesus my Lord
  - How He has changed and is changing my life.
10. Why is it essential not to paint a rose garden picture of what happens when someone makes Jesus their Lord, but to include the difficulties, struggles and suffering that may be a part of someone's Journey with Jesus?
11. Look for opportunities to share your story with others.
